#### Introduction

This document presents statistics of the Graduates for the 2023 April Graduation. The data was collected from the faculty officers and forwarded to the MIIR Office for processing, verification, and analysis and report compilation.

A total of 1741 awards were presented to 1720 graduates of which 936 (54.4%) were females. These graduates met the graduation requirements and were awarded with degrees, diplomas or certificates both at undergraduate and postgraduate level.
