Introduction

This document presents statistics of the Graduates for the 2022 October Graduation. The data was collected from the faculty officers and forwarded to the MIIR Office for processing, verification, and analysis and report compilation.

A total of 725 awards were presented to 720 graduates of which 344 (47.8%) were females. These graduates met the graduation requirements and were awarded with degrees, diplomas or certificates both at undergraduate and postgraduate level.

Figure 2.1: Awards by Offering Type


