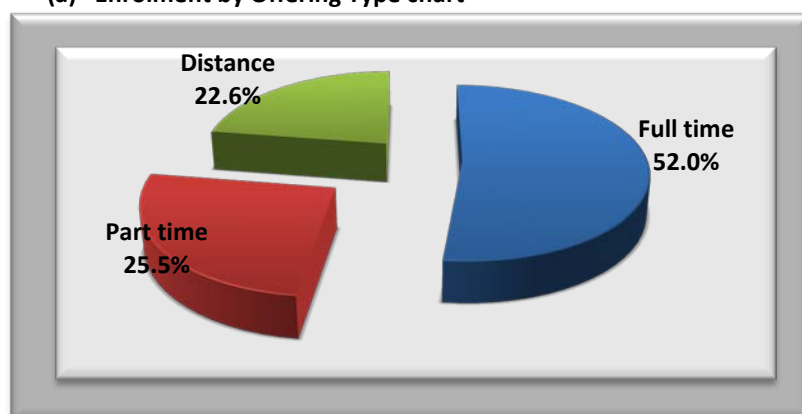
Data was retrieved from the database, analysed and presented in the form of tables and charts. The final census information is published only on 30 April 2012.

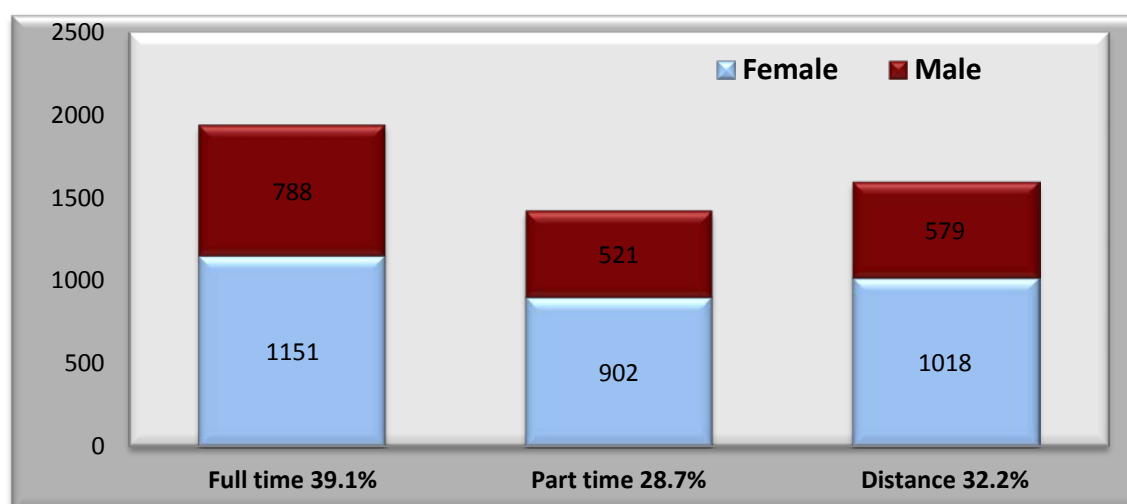

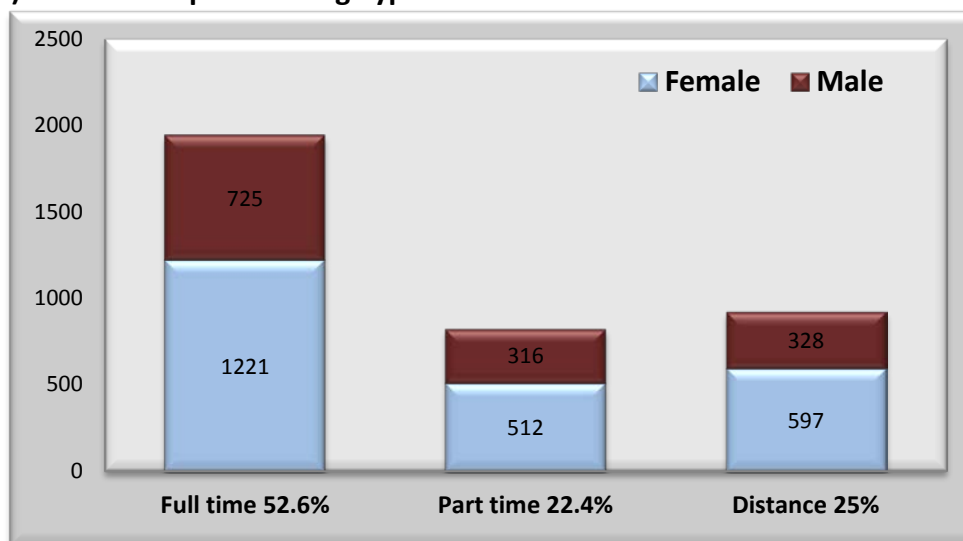

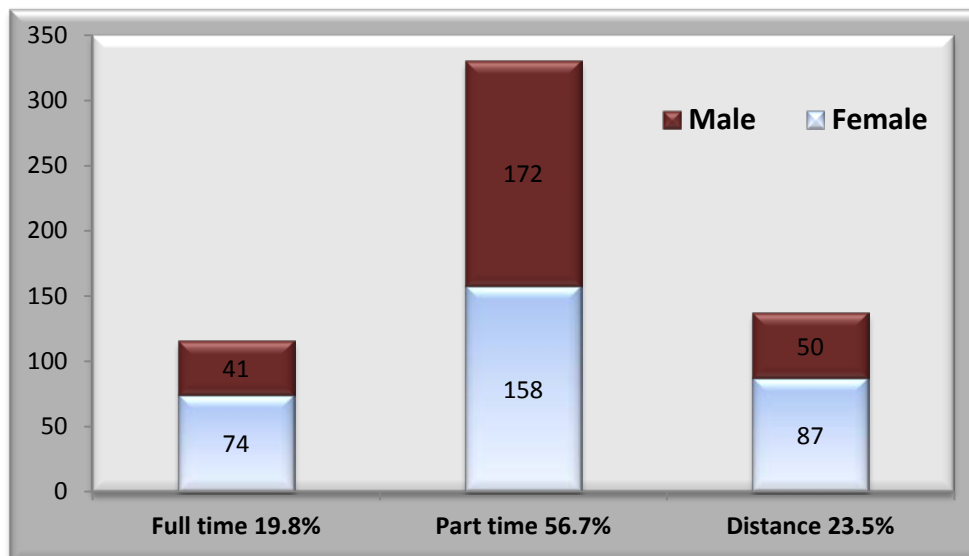

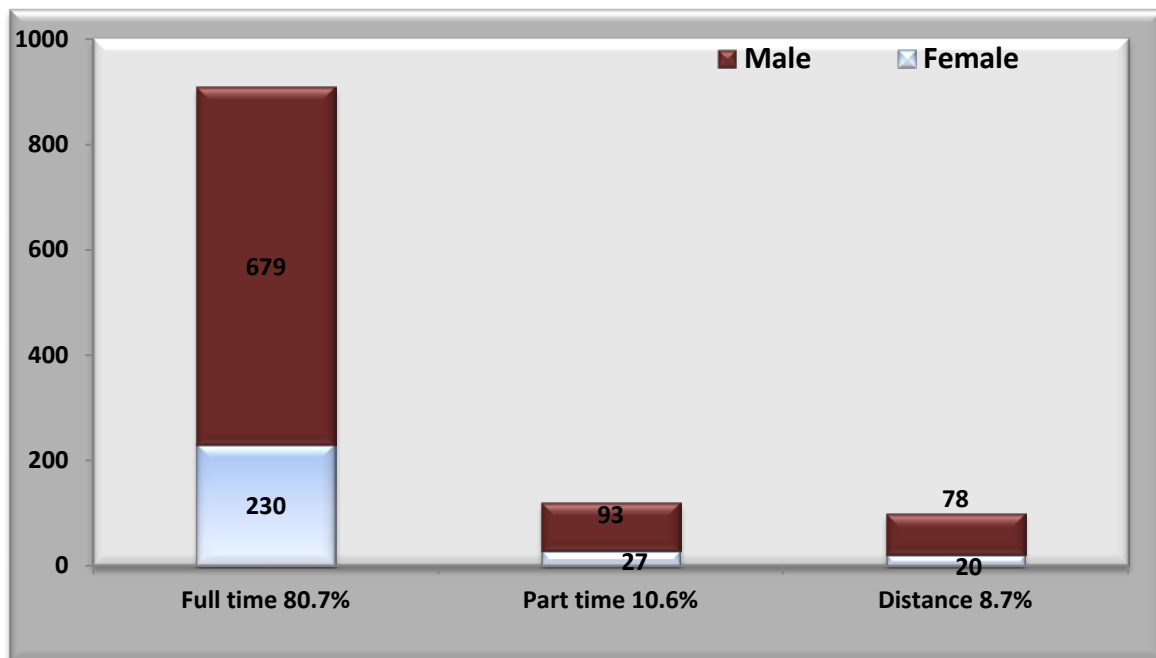

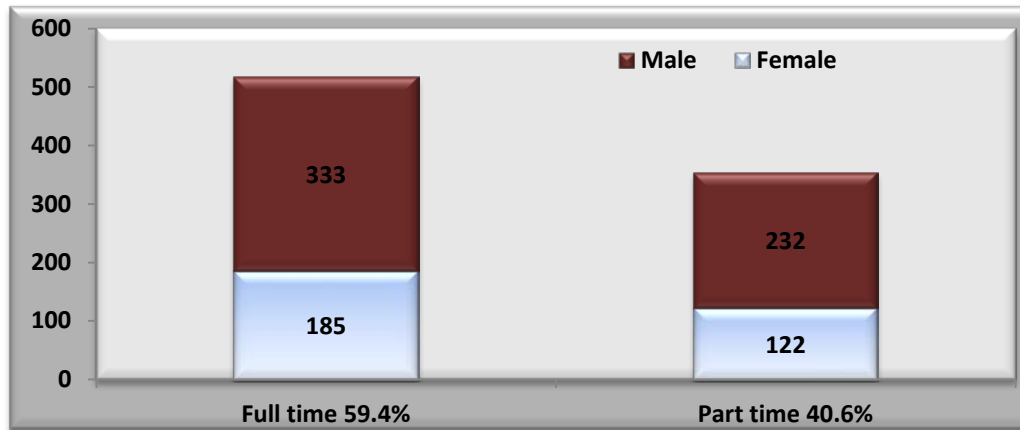
